Trained volunteers help and support families experiencing difficulties in the Modbury and Enfield areas to cope with parenting and personal issues.

Volunteers provide in home support for parents.

MOBILE CRÈCHE SERVICE

Pre-school child care is provided free of charge to assist parents who attend community courses.

ADMINISTRATION

Volunteers have the opportunity to work in a diverse range of reception and administration roles. This work provides valuable assistance to all aspects of Lutheran Community Care.

Located at Blair Athol, Tanunda, Mount Gambier and Morphett Vale

CARE & CLOTHING SHOPS

Our shops sell good quality and affordable pre-loved clothing, household goods and bric-a-brac. Volunteers can work as drivers, shop assistants, shop sorters, shed workers and maintenance workers.

Located at Blair Athol, Smithfield and Payneham

CHRISTMAS HAMPER APPEAL

Every year we distribute Christmas gifts to children and more than 500 Christmas hampers to families on low incomes.

Volunteers prepare and distribute hampers and assist in the toy cave.

Located at Blair Athol and Barossa Valley

COMMUNITY VISITORS SCHEME

Our trained volunteers make regular visits to people living in residential aged care facilities, providing friendship and companionship.

Volunteering Opportunities exist in the Barossa Valley, Adelaide Hills and the metropolitan area.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Volunteer opportunities exist to assist with all aspects of the distribution of newsletters. Assistance is also needed from those with journalist skills, letter/story writing, proof reading and for an historian - Lutheran Community Care family tree

EMERGENCY ACCOMMODATION

Calvary Lutheran Family Support Services provides short and medium term transitional supported accommodation and related services to families who are homeless or in crisis, including people experiencing domestic violence, or at imminent risk of becoming homeless. Volunteering opportunities include maintenance, cleaning and shed organisation.

Located at Morphett Vale, with an outreach service in Magill

EMERGENCY RELIEF

Clothing, food and other assistance is available to people who are experiencing hardship. This service provides assessment for practical assistance. Emergency relief volunteers assist people in need or packing food parcels. Volunteers also collect bread from bakeries for redistribution.

Located at Blair Athol and Barossa Valley

FAMILYZONE

FamilyZone is a community centre offering a range of services to families with children under five years. Volunteers are always needed in our onsite crèche; to visit vulnerable families and introduce them to the FamilyZone; to meet and greet families; to run our holiday programmes for children and to complete minor maintenance projects.

FINANCIAL COUNSELLING

Assistance is available with planning a budget, consumer rights, negotiation with creditors, concession eligibility, debt recovery and bankruptcy. Volunteers need to be trained financial counsellors for this position.
